



Look-Say-Cover-Write-Check



Materials Needed:

Manila Folders with top surface cut to open 1/3 at a time

Writing Paper

Pencils

Prepwork:

Prepare folders with 3 flaps.

Write the letters of the week or word wall words on a sheet of paper to align with the first opening of the folder

The writing paper underneath the second two flaps is blank.

Task:

Each student gets a manila folder.

Students are instructed to look under the first flap for the first word, say the word out loud, cover it, write it under the next flap, check it under the first, the write it again under the third.

Student Goals:

Learn to write a word or letter from memory after saying it

Improve editing skills
